6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the cancellation of
7 assistance checks not negotiated at
8 recipient's death."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 47.25 is amended by adding a new section to
11 read:

12 Sec. 47.25.265. CANCELLATION OF WARRANTS. (a) War-
13 rants issued to general relief assistance recipients after
14 the date of their death shall be returned to the Department
15 of Administration and cancelled.

16 (b) General relief assistance warrants issued prior
17 to the death of the recipient, but not negotiated at death,
18 shall be returned to the Department of Administration, and
19 shall be cancelled unless claimed by the authorized repre-
20 sentative of the estate of the recipient within 90 days
21 of the date of death.

22 (c) The state shall not be liable to the estate, heirs
23 or creditors of the deceased general relief assistance
24 recipient for payment on warrants cancelled under (a) and
25 (b) of this section.

26 * Sec. 2. AS 47.25 is amended by adding a new section to
27 read:

28 Sec. 47.25.515. CANCELLATION OF WARRANTS. (a) War-
29 rants issued to old age assistance recipients after the

1 date of their death shall be returned to the Department of
2 Administration and cancelled.

3 (b) Old age assistance warrants issued prior to the
4 death of the recipient, but not negotiated at death, shall
5 be returned to the Department of Administration, and shall be
6 cancelled unless claimed by the authorized representative
7 of the estate of the recipient within 90 days of the date
8 of death.

9 (c) The state shall not be liable to the estate, heirs
10 or creditors of the deceased old age assistance recipient
11 for payment on warrants cancelled under (a) and (b) of
12 this section.

13 * Sec. 3. AS 47.25 is amended by adding a new section to
14 read:

15 Sec. 47.25.745. CANCELLATION OF WARRANTS. (a) War-
16 rants issued to recipients of aid to the blind after the
17 date of their death shall be returned to the Department of
18 Administration and cancelled.

19 (b) Aid to the blind assistance warrants issued prior
20 to the death of the recipient, but not negotiated at death,
21 shall be returned to the Department of Administration, and
22 shall be cancelled unless claimed by the authorized repre-
23 sentative of the estate of the recipient within 90 days of
24 the date of death.

25 (c) The state shall not be liable to the estate, heirs
26 or creditors of the deceased recipient of aid to the blind
27 for payment on warrants cancelled under (a) and (b) of this
28 section.

29 * Sec. 4. AS 47.25 is amended by adding a new section to

2 Sec. 47.25.925. CANCELLATION OF WARRANTS. (a) War-
3 rants issued to recipients of aid to the permanently and
4 totally disabled after the date of their death shall be re-
5 turned to the Department of Administration and cancelled.

6 (b) Aid to the permanently and totally disabled war-
7 rants issued prior to the death of the recipient, but not
8 negotiated at death, shall be returned to the Department of
9 Administration, and shall be cancelled unless claimed by
10 the authorized representative of the estate of the recipient
11 within 90 days of the date of death.

12 (c) The state shall not be liable to the estate, heirs
13 or creditors of the deceased recipient of aid to the per-
14 manently and totally disabled for payment on warrants can-
15 celled under (a) and (b) of this section.
