HOUSE BILL NO. 263

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to areas subject to
vehicle regulations; and providing for an
effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.35.030 is amended to read:

Sec. 28.35.030. DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF
INTOXICATING LIQUOR OR DRUGS. A person who, while under the
influence of intoxicating liquor or narcotic drugs, operates
or drives an automobile, motorcycle or other motor vehicle
upon a public street, highway, or elsewhere [PUBLIC STREET
OR HIGHWAY] in the state upon conviction is punishable by
a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not
more than one year, or by both. Upon conviction for a
second or subsequent offense in violation of this section,
the offender's license, and his right to obtain a license,
to operate a motor vehicle shall be suspended for a period
of three years, and this suspension is in addition to any
other punishment fixed by the court.

* Sec. 2. AS 28.35.040(a) is amended to read:

(a) A person who drives an automobile, motorcycle or
other motor vehicle upon a public street, highway, or else-
where [PUBLIC STREET OR HIGHWAY] in the state carelessly,
heedlessly or in wilful or wanton disregard of the rights
or safety of others, or without due caution and circumspec-

1 tion, or at a speed or in a manner so as to endanger or be
2 likely to endanger a person or property is guilty of reck-
3 less driving, and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of
4 not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for a period of not
5 more than one year, or by both.

6 * Sec. 3. AS 28.35.040(b) is amended to read:

7 (b) It is unlawful for a person to operate a motor
8 vehicle in a negligent manner over and along a public street,
9 highway, or elsewhere. [THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS.] To operate
10 in a negligent manner means to operate a vehicle upon a
11 public street, highway, or elsewhere [THE HIGHWAYS] in such
12 a manner as to endanger a person or property.

13 * Sec. 4. AS 28.35.200 is amended to read:

14 Sec. 28.35.200. UNLAWFUL OPERATION OF VEHICLES. No
15 person may operate or move, nor any owner cause or permit
16 to be operated or moved upon any public highway a vehicle
17 in violation of secs. 50 [30] - 110, 130 - 260 of this
18 chapter or AS 28.05.010 - 28.05.040, or 28.05.060, or a
19 rule or regulation made under those sections.

20 * Sec. 5. AS 28.35.250 is amended to read:

21 Sec. 28.35.250. APPLICATION OF LAW. Secs. 50 [30] -
22 110, 130 - 260 of this chapter, or AS 28.05.010 - 28.05.040,
23 or 28.05.060, apply to streets of municipalities as well as
24 to roads and highways.

25 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
26 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
