6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the membership of the
7 Public Service Commission; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 42.05.020 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 42.05.020. COMPOSITION OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMMIS-
12 SION. The Public Service Commission consists of five [THREE]
13 members: two public members [,] appointed by the governor and
14 confirmed by the legislature in joint session assembled, the
15 director of air commerce, the director of motor transporta-
16 tion, and the executive director of the commission as appointed
17 by the commissioner of commerce and approved by the governor.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 42.05.030 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

19 Sec. 42.05.030. TERM OF OFFICE. Ex officio members of
20 the commission serve as members during their tenure in their
21 basic offices. The two public members are appointed for six-
22 year terms and the first two appointees shall serve for terms
23 of two years and four years as determined by the governor.

24 * Sec. 3. AS 42.05.040 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

25 Sec. 42.05.040. QUALIFICATIONS OF PUBLIC MEMBERS. The
26 public members of the commission shall have had professional
27 or business experience meeting the standards established by
28 the commissioner of commerce with the approval of the gover-
29 nor for those positions.
