6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making it a criminal offense to
7 give false information to law enforcement
8 officers; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 11.30 is amended by adding a new section to
12 read:

13 Sec. 11.30.330. FALSE REPORTS TO LAW ENFORCEMENT
14 OFFICERS. (a) Falsely Incriminating Another. A person
15 who knowingly gives false information to any law enforce-
16 ment officer with the intent to implicate another in the
17 commission of a crime commits a misdemeanor.

18 (b) Fictitious Reports. A person commits a mis-
19 demenor if he alleges to law enforcement officers that an
20 offense or other incident within their concern has occurred
21 knowing that it did not occur.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
23 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
