* Section 1. AS 14.20.220 is amended by adding a new sub-

section to read:

(f) Effective with the beginning of the school year in

1965, high school teachers who were not in the employ of

any school in the state as a teacher prior to that time,

16

must have the majority of academic credits on which their

17

master's degree is based in the subject or subjects they

18

teach to be eligible for the minimum teacher pay scale for

19

holders of master's degrees.
