BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 23.10 is amended by adding a new section to

Article 1 to read:

Sec. 23.10.037. LIE-DETECTOR TESTS. (a) No person

13

either personally or through an agent or representative may

14

request or suggest to a person in his employ or to a person

15

who has an application for employment pending before him or

16

require as a condition of employment that the employee or

17

applicant submit to an examination in which a polygraph or

18

other lie-detecting device is used.

19

(b) In this section "person" includes the state and a

20

political subdivision of the state.

21

(c) A person who violates this section is guilty of a

22

misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of

23

not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than

24

one year, or by both.
