6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to examinations in which  
7 polygraphs or other lie-detecting devices  
8 are used."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 23.10 is amended by adding a new section to  
11 Article 1 to read:

12 Sec. 23.10.037. LIE-DETECTOR TESTS. (a) No person  
13 either personally or through an agent or representative may  
14 request or suggest to a person in his employ or to a person  
15 who has an application for employment pending before him or  
16 require as a condition of employment that the employee or  
17 applicant submit to an examination in which a polygraph or  
18 other lie-detecting device is used.

19 (b) The provisions of (a) of this section do not apply  
20 to the state or a political subdivision of the state when  
21 dealing with policemen in its employ or with persons apply-  
22 ing to be employed as policemen.

23 (c) In this section "person" includes the state and a  
24 political subdivision of the state.

25 (d) A person who violates this section is guilty of a  
26 misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine or  
27 not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than  
28 one year, or by both.
