6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the taxation and regu-
7 lation of coin-operated devices; and pro-
8 viding for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 43.35.010(2) is amended to read:

11 (2) \$180 [\$120] a year for each coin-operated
12 device class 2;

13 * Sec. 2. AS 43.35.090(2) is amended to read:

14 (2) "coin-operated device class 2" means a pinball
15 machine, including a bingo type coin-operated device, horse
16 race machine or other apparatus or device which operates by
17 means of insertion of a coin, token, or similar object, and
18 which, by embodying the elements of chance or skill, awards
19 free plays and which contains a device for releasing free
20 plays and a meter for registering or recording the plays so
21 released, or with a provision for multiple coin insertion
22 for increasing the odds; class 2 does not include bona fide
23 vending machines in which gaming or amusement features are
24 not incorporated; the federal government has prohibited the
25 shipment of coin-operated devices or replacement parts for
26 those devices in interstate commerce and after June 30, 1967,
27 the operation of coin-operated devices class 2 are prohibited
28 in this state but prior to that time free plays may be trans-
29 ferred from one coin-operated device to another in the same
