6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the control of destruc-
7 tive dogs."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 03.55.040 is amended to read as follows:

10 Sec. 03.55.040. IMPOUNDING OR DESTRUCTION OF DOGS RUN-
11 NING AT LARGE AND THREATENING THE PEACE. (a) Any dog
12 running at large that is threatening the peace, person, or
13 property in any incorporated political subdivision of the
14 state, or within 10 miles of the boundaries of the political
15 subdivision, may be impounded. If the owner of the impounded
16 dog fails to claim the animal after a period of days to be
17 determined by the political subdivision and pay costs of
18 catching and impounding as fixed by the political subdivision,
19 the dog shall be destroyed or may be sold to pay costs.

20 (b) Any dog running at large that is threatening the
21 peace, person, or property in an area not within 10 miles of
22 a political subdivision may be destroyed by an individual
23 whose peace or person is threatened, or whose shelter, cache,
24 or other supplies have been damaged or destroyed by the dog,
25 provided that he has first made an attempt to locate the
26 owner, if any, of the dog, and has given him a reasonable
27 opportunity to control the dog.
