BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 07.30.100(b) is amended to read:

(b) If more than 40,000 people, as determined by the

11

Local Affairs Agency on the basis of the best available

12

information, reside in the area to be included in the pro-

13

posed organized borough, the Local Affairs Agency shall, as

14

soon as possible, and in no event later than 60 days before

15

the initial election of borough officers, establish sections

16

for the election of assemblymen, as provided in (a) of this

17

section. The first election of assemblymen shall be from

18

the sections established by this subsection. The members of

19

the borough assembly representing the area outside the first

20

class cities may vary the provisions of (a) of this section

21

to provide that in subsequent elections the qualified voters

22

of each section may vote only upon the candidacy of candi-

23

dates residing in that section.
