6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the commissioner of fish  
7 and game to waive big game tag requirements  
8 for military personnel; and providing for an  
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 16.05.330 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 16.05.330. LICENSES AND TAGS REQUIRED. It is un-  
13 lawful, except as otherwise permitted in this chapter, for a  
14 person to engage in sport fishing including the taking of  
15 razor clams, hunting, trapping, guiding, fur dealing, fish,  
16 fur, or game farming, or taxidermy without the appropriate  
17 license or tag and without having them in his actual  
18 possession. The commissioner of Fish and Game is authorized  
19 to waive the license and game tag requirements of this sec-  
20 tion for military personnel stationed in Alaska for over 30  
21 days if in his judgment he determines there is a need for a  
22 special harvesting of a stated type of game in a given area  
23 for a stated time due to overpopulation or predation or  
24 nuisance activity. The commissioner shall issue without fee  
25 permits for such harvesting by military personnel and specify  
26 on the permits the type of game, the area, and the time and  
27 bag limit covered by the permit.

28 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
29 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
