6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to service areas within
7 the first and second class borough."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 07.15.050(a) is amended to read:

10 Sec. 07.15.050. SERVICE AREAS. (a) Service areas to
11 provide special services within a first or second class
12 borough may be established, operated, altered, or abolished
13 by the assembly by ordinance adopted in the manner provided
14 in AS 07.20.100. Each ordinance adopted to establish or
15 abolish a service area must be approved by a majority of the
16 qualified voters voting on the question who reside in the
17 service area proposed to be established or abolished. Each
18 ordinance adopted to alter the powers, duties, or boundaries
19 of a service area must be approved by a majority of the
20 qualified voters voting on the question who reside in the
21 service area and in any area proposed to be added to the
22 service area.

23 * Sec. 2. AS 07.15.050(e) is amended to read:

24 (e) The assembly may delegate any of the powers pre-
25 scribed by sec. 710 of this chapter to a service area. Each
26 power may be delegated only by ordinance adopted in the man-
27 ner provided in AS 07.20.100. Each [IN A SECOND CLASS
28 BOROUGH, EACH] delegated power must be approved by a majority
29 of the qualified voters voting on the question who reside

within the service area. The rate of taxation and the
issuance of bonds shall remain subject to the approval of the
assembly.
