5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the legislature as  
7 the assembly for the unorganized borough;  
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 07.05 is amended by adding new sections to  
11 read:

12 Sec. 07.05.040. ASSEMBLY. The legislature, sitting  
13 as an unicameral body, acts as the assembly for the un-  
14 organized borough.

15 Sec. 07.05.050. ASSEMBLY OFFICERS. The president of  
16 the senate serves as temporary borough chairman until the  
17 permanent chairman is elected by a majority vote of the  
18 membership of the assembly. The assembly may provide for  
19 the election of additional officers.

20 Sec. 07.05.060. QUORUM. A simple majority of the  
21 membership to which the assembly is entitled constitutes  
22 a quorum to do business.

23 Sec. 07.05.070. RULES. The assembly may adopt rules  
24 for the conduct of its business by a majority vote of the  
25 membership of the assembly.

26 Sec. 07.05.080. POWERS. The assembly may pass ordi-  
27 nances relating to schools, planning and zoning, assessment  
28 and taxation, and any other subject or activity with which  
29 a first-class organized borough is empowered to deal.

1       \* Sec. 2. The Third Legislature shall convene and sit as the  
2 assembly of the unorganized borough beginning on the day follow-  
3 ing the adjournment of its second regular session in 1964.

4       \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
5 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
