For an Act entitled: "An Act creating a space-rental revolving
7 fund for vocational education; and providing
8 for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. PURPOSE. It is the purpose of this Act to create
11 and maintain a vocational education space rental revolving fund
12 for the rental of space for manpower training center programs pro-
13 vided for in the federal Vocational Education Act of 1963. Part
14 of the cost of leasing space for these programs is reimbursable
15 from federal sources.

Sec. 14.35.050. SPACE-RENTAL REVOLVING FUND. There is

18

created in the state treasury, subject to the jurisdiction of

19

the state Board of Education acting as the state Board of

20

Vocational Education, a space-rental revolving fund of

21

\$100,000 to be used for the renting of space required for

22

manpower training programs and centers under the federal

23

Vocational Education Act of 1963. Federal reimbursements for

24

the renting of space under provisions of federal law shall be

25

covered into the space-rental revolving fund. The board is

26

responsible through the department to annually request from

27

the legislature through the governor the necessary appropri-

28

ation to maintain the fund at the \$100,000 level.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1964.
