HOUSE BILL NO. 342

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the date upon which
the terms of office of members of the
Board of Dental Examiners shall begin."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.36.020 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.36.020. APPOINTMENT AND TERM OF SERVICE OF
MEMBERS. Members of the board are appointed by the governor,
subject to confirmation by the legislature in joint session
assembled. Each board member serves for a term of five
years, and until his successor is appointed and qualified.
The term begins on February 1. [JULY 1 OF THE YEAR OF AP-
POINTMENT.] An appointment to a vacancy is for the unexpired
term. Appointments shall be made from a list of names
recommended by the Alaska Dental Society. The list shall be
supplied at least 30 days before the beginning [EXPIRATION]
of a term and not more than 60 days after the occurrence of
a vacancy. The list shall contain at least two recommended
names for each appointment. The governor shall make the
appointment within 30 days after receiving the list.
