5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act dissolving mandatorily-incorporated  
7 organized boroughs; and providing for an  
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is to effect  
11 dissolution of those boroughs which were incorporated by direct  
12 state action under Secs. 1 - 4, Ch. 52, SLA 1963, and to provide  
13 for return to the state of state money loaned or given to, but not  
14 yet spent or obligated, by these boroughs. This Act is not ap-  
15 plicable to boroughs formed by local option.

16 \* Sec. 2. DISSOLUTION OF CERTAIN ORGANIZED BOROUGHES. The  
17 following organized boroughs are dissolved:

18 (1) Matanuska-Susitna Borough, designated in Sec. 3,  
19 Ch. 52, SLA 1963 as "Palmer-Wasilla-Talkeetna Election District  
20 #7";

21 (2) Greater Anchorage Area Borough, designated in Sec.  
22 3, Ch. 52, SLA 1963 as "Anchorage Election District #8";

23 (3) Kenai Peninsula Borough, designated in Sec. 3, Ch.  
24 52, SLA 1963 as "Combined Seward Election District #9 and Kenai-  
25 Cook Inlet Election District #10";

26 (4) North Star Borough, designated in Sec. 3, Ch. 52,  
27 SLA 1963 as "Fairbanks Election District #19 as designated in  
28 Sec. 3, Art. XIV, of the State Constitution", and as adjusted in  
29 boundaries by action of the Local Boundary Commission taking

1 effect March 13, 1964.

2 \* Sec. 3. Within 30 days the director of local affairs shall  
3 collect and deposit in the general fund of the state the amount of  
4 organizational grants and all other money given or loaned each  
5 organized borough designated in sec. 2 of this Act. However, this  
6 section applies only to money which, before the effective date of  
7 this Act, has not been expended or obligated to be expended by a  
8 duly-adopted ordinance, resolution, motion, or order of the  
9 borough assembly.

10 \* Sec. 4. SUCCESSION. The property of and debts owing to the  
11 boroughs dissolved by this Act become the property of the state.

12 \* Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect on the day  
13 after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law with-  
14 out such approval.
