HOUSE BILL NO. 359

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the payment of pre-  
vailing wages to state employees employed on  
temporary force-account projects; and pro-  
viding for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 39.27 is amended by adding a new section to  
read:

Sec. 39.27.020. FORCE ACCOUNT WAGES. (a) Neither sec.  
10 of this chapter nor AS 39.25.150(2) applies to mechanics,  
laborers, or surveyors on temporary force-account projects.

(b) A person working on a temporary force-account  
project as a mechanic, laborer, or surveyor shall be paid the  
hourly wage prevailing for work similar to the work he is  
doing in the area in which he is working.

(c) The person making the payment under (b) of this  
section shall determine the prevailing hourly wage by refer-  
ring to the list of prevailing hourly wages published and  
distributed by the commissioner of labor.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1964.
