11 There is created [WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE] the
12 Public Service Commission.
13 * Sec. 2. AS 42.05.080 is amended to read:
14 Sec. 42.05.080. ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT [SUPERVISION] OF
15 COMMISSION. The commission may receive [IS UNDER THE] gener-
16 al administrative support from the Department of Commerce
17 [SUPERVISION OF THE COMMISSIONER OF COMMERCE].
18 * Sec. 3. AS 42.05.090 is amended to read:
19 Sec. 42.05.090. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. The commission
20 [COMMISSIONER OF COMMERCE] shall appoint an [THE] executive
21 director of the commission. The executive director may be a
22 member of the commission. He is responsible for and has the
23 authority to carry out all powers and duties of the commis-
24 sion between its meetings, except as his responsibility and
25 authority may be specifically limited by the commission.
26 * Sec. 4. AS 42.05.160 is amended to read:
27 Sec. 42.05.160. EMPLOYMENT AND COMPENSATION OF COMMIS-
28 SION PERSONNEL. [THE COMMISSION MAY EMPLOY AN EXECUTIVE
29 DIRECTOR.] The executive director shall be an experienced

1 administrator. The commission may employ engineers,
2 examiners, hearing officers, experts, clerks, accountants,
3 and other assistants as it considers necessary and fix the
4 compensation for them.
