6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the occupation of  
7 barbering; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 08.12 is amended by adding a new section to  
11 read:

12 Sec. 08.12.075. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE. A person  
13 is entitled to be licensed as a barber who meets the re-  
14 quirements of sec. 320 of this chapter.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.12 is amended by adding new sections to read:

16 ARTICLE 6. APPRENTICE BARBERS.

17 Sec. 08.12.300. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE OF APPRENTICE  
18 BARBER. To be entitled to be licensed as an apprentice  
19 barber a person must have

20 (1) educational requirements specified by this  
21 chapter or by regulations of the board;

22 (2) completed a course of study and training in,  
23 and received a diploma from, an approved barber college in  
24 the state;

25 (3) applied to the board for an examination with-  
26 in six months from the date of graduation from the approved  
27 barber college;

28 (4) passed an examination given by the board.

29 Sec. 08.12.310. FAILURE TO PASS OR APPLY FOR EXAMINATION.

1 An applicant who fails an examination or fails to apply for  
2 an examination within six months of the time he graduates  
3 from an approved barber college must re-enroll in an approved  
4 barber college and pass further courses specified by the  
5 board.

6 Sec. 08.12.320. ENTITLEMENT TO EXAMINATION AND LICEN-  
7 SURE AS A BARBER. An apprentice barber is entitled to take  
8 an examination, prescribed by the board, and, if he passes  
9 it, to be licensed as a barber after he has served as an  
10 apprentice barber for not less than two years under the  
11 immediate personal supervision of a licensed barber. If he  
12 fails the examination, he must practice as an apprentice  
13 barber for six months before he may apply for another ex-  
14 amination.

15 Sec. 08.12.330. AFFIDAVIT. An apprentice barber  
16 shall file an affidavit with the board at the end of each  
17 six months for a two-year period from the date he is licensed  
18 as an apprentice barber. Only one apprentice barber shall  
19 be employed in any licensed barber shop. No apprentice  
20 barber shall be allowed to barber for more than three years  
21 on an apprentice barber license. The board may revoke or  
22 suspend the license of a licensed barber who refuses to sign  
23 a true affidavit, and may sign the affidavit in the place  
24 of the barber. An apprentice barber who does not file the  
25 affidavit may not take the examination.

26 ARTICLE 7. BARBER SHOP LICENSE.

27 Sec. 08.12.350. LICENSE REQUIRED. No person may own  
28 or operate a barber shop the operation of which begins after  
29 the effective date of this section without its having been

Sec. 08.12.360. REQUIREMENT FOR LICENSURE. No barber shop may be licensed until it complies with the requirements of this chapter and the regulations of the board.

Sec. 08.12.370. TIME FOR ISSUING LICENSE. No license to operate a barber shop may be issued for at least a reasonable time after application is made for it.

Sec. 08.12.090. LICENSE FEE FOR BARBERS AND APPRENTICE BARBERS. The annual fee for a license to engage in barbering or apprentice barbering is \$10.

Sec. 08.12.115. LICENSE FEE FOR BARBER SHOP. The annual fee for a license to operate a barber shop is \$10.

\* Sec. 6. AS 08.12.180 and 08.12.270 are repealed.
