For an Act entitled: "An Act to make regular part-time employees  
7 of the state eligible for benefits of the  
8 Public Employees' Retirement System."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 39.35.680(5) is amended to read:

(5) "employee" means a person who receives re-

12

muneration for [FULL-TIME] personal services regularly

13

rendered on a full-time basis or on a part-time basis for a

14

period totaling at least the equivalent of three months full-

15

time service within a calendar year to an employer or who

16

would receive remuneration except for an authorized leave of

17

absence, excluding (A) persons compensated on a contractual

18

or fee basis, (B) casual or part-time workers in a position

19

having duties which will not permit the accumulation of a

20

total time employed equivalent to at least three [SIX] months

21

of service during a calendar year, (C) persons covered by the

22

Alaska teachers' retirement system, (D) employees of the

23

division of marine transportation engaged in operating the

24

state ferry system who are covered by a union or group

25

retirement system to which the state makes contributions, and

26

(E) justices and judges of the supreme and superior courts

27

of Alaska;
