BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.20.280 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.20.280. BASIS OF LEAVE. A teacher who has

12

rendered active service for seven or more [CONSECUTIVE] years

13

in a public school system in the state is entitled to

14

sabbatical leave, subject to the restrictions of secs. 280 -

15

350 of this chapter. Sabbatical leave may be taken for

16

educational purposes only, and for not more than one school

17

year. A teacher on sabbatical leave is entitled to one-half

18

his base salary to be paid in the usual manner.

Sec. 14.20.340. MILITARY SERVICE AND PREVIOUS LEAVES

OF ABSENCE. To determine eligibility for sabbatical leave,

22

tours of military service and leaves of absence granted

23

before July 1, 1963, are not [CONSIDERED BREAKS IN SEQUENCE

24

OF SERVICE, NOR ARE THEY] considered years of active service.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
26 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
