For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the transfer of state

lands to organized boroughs."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 07.10.150 is amended to read:

10

Sec. 07.10.150. STATE LANDS. An organized borough may

11

select 10 per cent of the total lands within the borough.

12

Such lands shall be vacant, unappropriated, unreserved state

13

lands, including tidelands and submerged lands, located in

14

its boundaries [WITHIN FIVE YEARS] after the date of avail-

15

ability of state lands in the borough. Nothing in this sec-

16

tion affects any valid existing claim, location, or entry

17

under the laws of the state or the United States, whether for

18

homestead, mineral, right-of-way, or other purpose, or affects

19

the rights of any owner, claimant, locator, or entryman to

20

the full use and enjoyment of the land so occupied.
