6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to mental retardation."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 18.05 is amended by adding a new section to  
9 read:

10 Sec. 18.05.031. PROGRAM PLANNING FOR MENTALLY RE-

11 TARDED. (a) The department shall

12 (1) plan for and take other steps leading to  
13 comprehensive state and community action to combat mental  
14 retardation;

15 (2) be the sole agency for carrying out the  
16 purposes of the federal act;

17 (3) make applications for, receive, and expend  
18 grants under the federal act. The applications shall set  
19 forth plans and contain provisions and assurances for the  
20 expenditure of any grant as required by the federal act or  
21 the Secretary.

22 (b) As used in this section

23 (1) "federal act" means Title XVII of the Social  
24 Security Act, Grants for Planning Comprehensive Action to  
25 Combat Mental Retardation (P.L. 88-156);

26 (2) "Secretary" means the Secretary of Health,  
27 Education, and Welfare or his designee.
