HOUSE BILL NO. 417

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for the observance of
Arbor Day in Alaska; and providing for an
effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 41.15 is amended by adding a new section to
read:

ARTICLE 3. FOREST RESOURCE CONSERVATION.

Sec. 41.15.400. OBSERVANCE OF ARBOR DAY. To increase
public awareness of the vital importance of the conservation
and propagation of trees and forests to the everyday life of
the citizens of Alaska, the second Friday in May of every year
is designated "Arbor Day." It shall be observed by appropri-
ate school assemblies and programs, and is the occasion for
other suitable observances and exercises by civic groups and
the public in general.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
