5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to establish an educational founda-
7 tion advisory committee; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE. There
11 is created an Educational Foundation Advisory Committee in the
12 Office of the Governor.

13 * Sec. 2. COMPOSITION AND TERMS OF OFFICE. (a) The committee
14 consists of seven members who, unless otherwise provided for in
15 (b) of this section, are appointed by the governor for the dura-
16 tion of this Act.

17 (b) The governor shall appoint to the committee

18 (1) the chairman of the House Health, Welfare and Edu-
19 cation Committee,

20 (2) the chairman of the Senate Health, Welfare and Edu-
21 cation Committee,

22 (3) a representative of the Department of Education,

23 (4) a representative of the University of Alaska,

24 (5) the superintendent of a public school district,

25 (6) a representative of the Alaska Education Associa-
26 tion,

27 (7) one other person.

28 * Sec. 3. PER DIEM AND TRANSPORTATION. Members of the com-
29 mittee are entitled to transportation allowances and per diem

1 provided by law, unless money is made available for transportation
2 expenses and living costs from other sources.

3 * Sec. 4. EXECUTIVE SECRETARY. The committee may employ an
4 executive secretary or use the staff of the Legislative Council to
5 assist the committee in performing its duties.

6 * Sec. 5. DUTIES. The committee shall confer with all private
7 organizations and persons that make money available for any educa-
8 tional purpose, including scholarships, building construction,
9 equipment, teacher training and education, and course planning, to
10 determine what state action is necessary to accept the money. The
11 committee shall recommend to the legislature and the governor any
12 action the legislative or executive branches can take to make the
13 state eligible to receive grants and loans for educational pur-
14 poses from private organizations and persons. The committee
15 shall make its recommendations no later than the beginning of the
16 1965 regular session of the legislature.

17 * Sec. 6. This Act expires on March 1, 1965.

18 * Sec. 7. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
19 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
