5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to expenditure and account-  
7 ing of funds disbursed from the Federal  
8 Transitional Grants Account in the General  
9 Fund; and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. The purpose of this Act is to insure that funds  
12 granted by Congress to assist the state in meeting the natural  
13 disaster of March 27, 1964 are allocated and used for the purposes  
14 intended by Congress.

15 \* Sec. 2. The Commissioner of Administration shall disburse  
16 funds appropriated from the Federal Transitional Grants Account  
17 for the purposes for which said funds were intended by Congress  
18 to be used.

19 \* Sec. 3. Funds appropriated from the Federal Transitional  
20 Grants Account for payment to municipalities and school districts  
21 to meet shortfalls in revenue caused by the natural disaster of  
22 March 27, 1964, shall be disbursed by the Commissioner of Adminis-  
23 tration. No funds shall be disbursed under this Act until the  
24 municipality or school district in need of funds because of short-  
25 fall in revenue applies to the Commissioner of Administration in  
26 a manner to be prescribed by him. Municipalities and school dis-  
27 tricts receiving funds under this Act shall account to the Commis-  
28 sioner of Administration for the expenditure of said funds. Prior  
29 to disbursing funds to municipalities or school districts from the

1 Federal Transitional Grants Account the Commissioner of Adminis-  
2 tration may require a written agreement with said municipalities  
3 or school districts relating to the expenditure and accounting  
4 for said funds.

5 \* Sec. 4. The Commissioner of Administration is authorized  
6 to disburse to municipalities and school districts in an amount  
7 not to exceed \$3,200,000 for the purposes authorized in this Act.

8 \* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
9 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.  
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
