6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending the provisions of Ch. 101,
7 SLA 1964 relating to the accounting and
8 expenditure of funds in the Federal
9 Transitional Grants Account; and providing
10 for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. Sec. 3, Ch. 101, SLA 1964 is amended to read:

13 Sec. 3. Funds appropriated from the Federal Transition-
14 al Grants Account for payment to municipalities and school
15 districts to meet shortfalls in revenue and extraordinary
16 expenses caused by the natural disaster of March 27, 1964,
17 shall be disbursed by the commissioner of administration,
18 No funds shall be disbursed under this Act until the muni-
19 cipality or school district in need of funds because of the
20 shortfall in revenue and extraordinary expenses applies to
21 the commissioner of administration in a manner to be pre-
22 scribed by him. Municipalities and school districts receiv-
23 ing funds under this Act shall account to the commissioner
24 of administration for the expenditure of the funds. Before
25 disbursing funds to municipalities or school districts from
26 the Federal Transitional Grants Account, the commissioner
27 of administration may require a written agreement with the
28 municipalities or school districts relating to the expendi-
29 ture and accounting for the funds.

* Sec. 2. Sec. 4, Ch. 101, SLA 1964, is amended to read:

Sec. 4. The commissioner of administration is authorized to disburse to municipalities and school districts in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000 [\$3,200,000] for the purposes authorized in this Act.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
