HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to an audit of the value of
facilities and revenues of a state-
owned airport before consideration
of any transfer to a city.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
CURRING:

WHEREAS legislation has been introduced proposing the trans-
fer of the state-owned Anchorage International Airport to the
City of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS this airport and its facilities represent the prop-
erty and investment of all citizens and taxpayers of the state;
and

WHEREAS, prior to considering any transfer, it behooves the
Legislature on behalf of all the citizens of Alaska to know
exactly what present and potential value would be transferred by
the state to a political subdivision;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested
to direct that an audit of the value of the airfield, buildings,
appurtenances, equipment and furnishings, and the present and
anticipated revenue of the Anchorage International Airport be
made by an independent and qualified auditing firm, and that the
resulting report be reviewed by the Legislature before any action
is taken by the state to surrender control of the Anchorage In-
ternational Airport.
