ues to be a vital factor in the economy of the state; and

WHEREAS, the high school curriculum of the state does not

offer any course on the subject of fisheries; and

WHEREAS, the State of Maine offers its high school students

15

a practical course in marine biology and other aspects of the

fishing industry in recognition of the importance of that industry

to that state and its people;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to have the

Department of Education, with the cooperation of the Department

of Fish and Game, investigate the feasibility of offering a high

21

school course in fisheries to students residing in the coastal

22

areas of the state and report its findings and recommendations to

the Legislature as soon as possible.
