5 Relating to a high school course
6 in fisheries in coastal areas of
7 the state.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS, the harvesting of fish and seafood products contin-
11 ues to be a vital factor in the economy of the state; and

12 WHEREAS, the high school curriculum of the state does not
13 offer any course on the subject of fisheries; and

14 WHEREAS, the State of Maine offers its high school students
15 a practical course in marine biology and other aspects of the
16 fishing industry in recognition of the importance of that industry
17 to that state and its people;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to have the
19 Department of Education, with the cooperation of the University of
20 Alaska and of the Department of Fish and Game, investigate the
21 feasibility of offering a high school course in fisheries to
22 students residing in the coastal areas of the state and report its
23 findings and recommendations to the Legislature as soon as possible.
