5 Relating to the use of rented  
6 office space by state agencies.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-  
8 CURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the renting of office space for state agencies has  
10 become an expense item of considerable importance in the operat-  
11 ing costs of the state government; and

12 WHEREAS, the renting of office space, current or planned, is  
13 in many cases not noted in agency budget documents; and

14 WHEREAS, there is an apparent need for close surveillance of  
15 the existing and expanding use by state agencies of rented office  
16 space;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the  
18 Department of Administration to: (1) require all state agencies  
19 now renting or seeking to rent office space to report that fact  
20 with supporting figures in its budget document; (2) make and  
21 publish a determination of what space is required for the staff,  
22 furniture, equipment and storage for each agency; and (3) disallow  
23 any agency request for rented office space when the request is  
24 not supported by a legislative authorization for the hiring of  
25 additional personnel, a new program, or the procurement of addi-  
26 tional furniture, equipment, or storage space for an existing or  
27 new program.
