5 Relating to the cost of travel

6 and per diem of state employees.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-  
8 CURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the cost of the travel and per diem for employees  
10 on the business of the state is an item of considerable expense  
11 to the state treasury; and

12 WHEREAS, surveillance of transportation and per diem  
13 practices and claims of state employees must be kept at peak  
14 efficiency if unauthorized or unnecessarily expensive practices  
15 are to be avoided; and

16 WHEREAS, it appears that the work of the Department of  
17 Administration would be facilitated if all claims for transporta-  
18 tion costs and per diem were approved or disallowed on the basis  
19 of the use of the most efficient and least expensive means of  
20 transportation while traveling on the business of the state;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is urged to direct the  
22 heads of all departments of state government to approve or  
23 disallow claims for transportation reimbursement and per diem on  
24 the basis of the use of the most efficient and least expensive  
25 means of transportation for any person traveling on state business.
