5 Relating to the use of aircraft in hunt-  
6 ing big game, particularly brown bear in  
7 unit 9.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-  
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS, the rapidly increasing use of aircraft in the taking  
11 of big game, particularly brown bear in unit 9, has created con-  
12 siderable adverse national publicity; and

13 WHEREAS, the use of aircraft for the taking of big game  
14 animals, particularly brown bear in unit 9, if continued, will  
15 jeopardize the stocks; and

16 WHEREAS, the image of Alaskan guided hunts will also be  
17 seriously harmed with a resultant loss of revenue and tourism to  
18 the state;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Fish and Game is urged to  
20 adopt regulations to require that aircraft may only be used for  
21 transporting hunters and guides to and from previously established  
22 camps; and that the phrase "previously established camp" be  
23 defined as a camp the location of which has been preregistered  
24 with the Department of Fish and Game before the start of the hunt.
