5 Relating to the use of aircraft in hunt-
6 ing brown bear in unit 9.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
8 CURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the rapidly increasing use of aircraft in the taking
10 of brown bear in unit 9 has created considerable adverse national
11 publicity; and

12 WHEREAS, the use of aircraft for the taking of brown bear in
13 unit 9, if continued, will jeopardize the stocks; and

14 WHEREAS, the image of Alaskan guided hunts will also be
15 seriously harmed with a resultant loss of revenue and tourism to
16 the state;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Fish and Game is urged to
18 consider regulations requiring that in the hunting of brown bear
19 in unit 9, hunters and guides may only use aircraft to and from
20 previously established camps; and that the phrase "previously
21 established camp" might possibly be defined as a camp the location
22 of which has been preregistered with the Department of Fish and
23 Game before the start of the hunt.
