6 unemployment and workmen's compensa-  
7 tion to residents of villages and  
8 remote areas.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CONCUR-  
10 RING:

11 WHEREAS, due to the lack of road access, communication facili-  
12 ties, and newspapers, many areas of the state do not have the  
13 facilities and opportunities to become aware of rights and obliga-  
14 tions under state laws and regulations implementing them; and

15 WHEREAS the state is responsible for extensive programs for  
16 unemployment compensation and workmen's compensation which are  
17 of concern and value to all citizens in all areas; and

18 WHEREAS there is an apparent need for the disseminating of  
19 this information and providing assistance relative to unemployment  
20 and workmen's compensation in the scattered villages and remote  
21 areas;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to  
23 direct the Department of Labor to have a person versed in the un-  
24 employment compensation and workmen's compensation programs appear  
25 at announced public meetings in the remote village and rural areas  
26 to advise and assist citizens in those areas with questions and  
27 problems on the programs.
