7 taxation matters.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS the orderly payment of taxes is an essential element
11 of good citizenship and good government; and

12 WHEREAS information on technical aspects of and changes in
13 state tax laws is available to most citizens of the state through
14 main or field tax offices and newspapers; and

15 WHEREAS this vital service is not available to citizens liv-
16 ing in scattered villages and rural areas of the state and the
17 lack of this service is a detriment to both the residents of
18 those areas and the state treasury;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested
20 to direct the Department of Revenue to assign a person or persons
21 to visit as many villages and rural communities as possible each
22 year on an announced schedule to hold public meetings to explain
23 the tax laws of the state as they apply to local citizens and to
24 provide them with any assistance which is needed or requested.
