BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-

WHEREAS, Alaska's administrative regulations comprise an

11

important body of law; and

WHEREAS, in several areas of law such as natural resources,

13

health and welfare, education, and fish and game, the regulations

14

affect the public more directly than the statutes in those areas

15

do; and

WHEREAS, administrative regulations are compiled into the

17

Alaska Administrative Code; and

18

WHEREAS, the code is poorly drafted, has no usable index, is

19

confusingly organized, and is printed on paper and with type that

20

is hard to read;

BE IT RESOLVED that the legislative council is directed to

22

study alternative methods for, and costs of, revising the Alaska

23

Administrative Code and to submit a report on its study to the

24

members of the legislature at the beginning of the 1964 legis-

lative session.
