6 U. S. Savings Stamp program in the  
7 schools of the state.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CONCUR-  
9 RING:

10 WHEREAS leaders in finance, industry, and education agree that  
11 this country needs more savings of all kinds to assure our continu-  
12 ing growth and prosperity; and

13 WHEREAS the U. S. Treasury sponsored school Savings Stamp pro-  
14 gram, which has enjoyed nation-wide success in every state in the  
15 Union except Alaska, is one good way of teaching thrift to aid in  
16 this accumulation of greater national savings; and

17 WHEREAS the teaching of thrift as a character building train-  
18 ing for youngsters is properly within the province of the class-  
19 room; and

20 WHEREAS schools can and should teach thrift as a benefit, not  
21 only to individual students, but to the Nation; and

22 WHEREAS there is now a U. S. Savings Bonds office in Alaska  
23 which will aid in the inauguration of a school Savings Stamp pro-  
24 gram in Alaska;

25 BE IT RESOLVED that the state Department of Education is urged  
26 to encourage the inauguration of a U. S. Savings Stamp program in  
27 the schools in the State of Alaska; and be it

28 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the  
29 state Board of Education and the state director of the U. S. Savings
