9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
10 CURRING:

11 WHEREAS, the Department of Highways has formulated the pri-
12 mary road system in the Anchorage urban area, but has not yet
13 formulated the secondary road system; and

14 WHEREAS, the need for the secondary road system is in many
15 cases as pressing as for the primary road system; and

16 WHEREAS, that need is felt particularly in the lack of a
17 direct access route from the city to the International Airport
18 Road; and

19 WHEREAS, if "C" Street were extended from Sixth Avenue to
20 beyond the International Airport Road, it would be a direct traffic
21 route out of Anchorage to the airport and the residential area
22 south of the city, affording early, inexpensive relief of the
23 Anchorage area's traffic congestion;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully urged to
25 direct the Department of Highways to hold informal public hearings
26 and, as soon as possible, to designate the Federal Aid Secondary
27 Road System in the Anchorage urban area, giving particular prior-
28 ity to classifying an extension of "C" Street to past the Inter-
29 national Airport Road in the secondary road system.
