8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-  
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS, the state and its political subdivisions are con-  
11 tinually confronted with serious problems of many kinds resulting  
12 from the law being broken by juveniles; and

13 WHEREAS, some of the law-breaking and its attendant problems  
14 result from the lack of understanding by young persons of their  
15 responsibility to other persons and to society for their own con-  
16 duct, and from ignorance about the manner in which the law is  
17 enforced; and

18 WHEREAS, the state owes a responsibility to young persons to  
19 educate them in these matters; and

20 WHEREAS, it would be possible for the Department of Law to  
21 prepare and disseminate throughout the state for a small cost an  
22 easily read and understandable pamphlet explaining to juveniles  
23 what rights the law gives them, what conduct it requires of them,  
24 what the consequences are of breaking the law, and how the law is  
25 enforced;

26 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Law is urged to prepare,  
27 reproduce as cheaply as possible, and disseminate as widely as  
28 possible a pamphlet for young people about the law, the rights it  
29 gives, and the duties and responsibilities it imposes.
