8 the business license application.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
10 CURRING:

11 WHEREAS, no means now exists for the Department of Labor to
12 determine whether employers or businesses have their employees
13 covered by workmen's compensation as required by law; and

14 WHEREAS, the availability of this information would be of
15 value to the Department in protecting the interests of employees
16 in general and those businesses already properly covered;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested
18 to direct the Commissioner of Revenue to include on the appli-
19 cation forms for a business license the following questions;

- 20 (1) Are your employees covered by workmen's compensation?;
21 (2) What is the name of the firm providing the coverage?; and
22 (3) When does the current coverage expire?
