2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 18

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to a study of local
6 service roads.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
8 CURRING:

9 WHEREAS, local service roads are important to the development
10 of Alaska; and

11 WHEREAS, there is no federal, state or local government pro-
12 gram of construction and maintenance of local service roads; and

13 WHEREAS, the Governor of Alaska has transmitted to the legis-
14 lature a preliminary report of a Study of Local Service Roads
15 prepared by the Department of Highways; and

16 WHEREAS, consideration should be given to:

17 (1) Establishment of responsibility for local service
18 roads;

19 (2) Scope of the program which can be feasibly under-
20 taken on a statewide basis; and

21 (3) Methods of financing the costs of construction and
22 maintenance;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council, with the cooper-
24 ation of the Department of Highways, Local Affairs Agency, and
25 other affected executive branch agencies, is directed to study the
26 preliminary report of A Study of Local Service Roads prepared by
27 the Department of Highways and the general subject of local ser-
28 vice roads, including responsibility for such roads, feasible
29 programs and methods of financing costs of construction and

1 maintenance. A report of such study, with recommendations and
2 suggested legislation, shall be submitted to the legislature at
3 the time of convening of the First Session of the Fourth Legisla-
4 ture in 1965.
