HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 23

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting notification to the
General Services Administration
expressing no further interest
in the Port of Whittier facilities.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
CURRING:

WHEREAS, feasibility studies on the Port of Whittier facil-
ities for the Department of Health and Welfare programs resulted
in adverse conclusions; and

WHEREAS, the same conclusions were reached in an earlier
study regarding the use of the Port of Whittier facilities as a
state prison; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has no further specific use in
mind for the Port of Whittier facilities; and

WHEREAS, disposition of the Port of Whittier properties by
the General Services Administration is being needlessly delayed
by the State of Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is earnestly requested to
submit a letter as soon as practicable to the General Services
Administration, Mr. C. E. Ocamb, Chief, Real Property Division,
Utilization and Disposal Service, Auburn, Washington, notifying
said agency that the State of Alaska has no further interest in
the Port of Whittier facilities.
