BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-

CURRING:

WHEREAS, the sound and orderly development of Alaska's high-

11

way system is a matter of vital concern to all Alaskans; and

12

WHEREAS, there exists no statutory or administrative formulae

13

governing the allocation of highway funds, and no published policy

14

guidelines for the development of the highway system; and

15

WHEREAS, through the establishment of an equitable formula or

16

statutory guidelines the Legislature can assist in avoiding in-

17

equities in allocation of funds; and

18

WHEREAS, if the Legislature is to have the proper information

19

at its disposal to establish a policy and guidelines, interim

20

study of the problem is required;

21

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to

22

study the problem of the allocation among the various areas of the

23

state of the funds for the construction of primary and secondary

24

roads, and to prepare recommendations for a formula, or guidelines,

25

or both; and be it

26

FURTHER RESOLVED, that in doing so it take into account at

27

least the factors of population, motor vehicle fuel tax receipts,

28

traffic statistics, and motor vehicle registrations; and be it

29

FURTHER RESOLVED, that it submit its recommendations to the

1 First Session of the Fourth Legislature in January, 1965.
