4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the establishment of a Coast
6 Guard station at the mouth of Cook Inlet.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the year around shipment of freight by tug, barge, and
9 ship on Cook Inlet is increasing each year; and

10 WHEREAS tankers are now making regular year- round trips to
11 Cook Inlet for the purpose of moving Alaska oil; and

12 WHEREAS the commercial fishery of the lower Cook Inlet area
13 is of considerable volume and is increasing on a year - round basis;
14 and

15 WHEREAS this great and increasing volume of commercial mari-
16 time activity requires expanded area services for the protection
17 of this commerce and those who engage in it;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable John F. Kennedy, President
19 of the United States, is respectfully requested to have the Secre-
20 tary of the Treasury direct the installation of a U. S. Coast Guard
21 station on the lower Kenai Peninsula near the mouth of Cook Inlet;
22 and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the
24 Honorable Douglas Dillon, Secretary of the Treasury; Vice Admiral
25 E. J. Roland, Commandant, U. S. Coast Guard; and the members of
26 the Alaska delegation in Congress.
