8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS, the welfare and growth of Alaska has depended
10 heavily upon the communication system provided by the Alaska
11 Communication System; and

12 WHEREAS, since 1903 the Alaska Communication System has
13 given unexcelled service in the remotest areas of Alaska and
14 under the most difficult hardships; and

15 WHEREAS, the Alaska Communication System has been vigorous,
16 progressive, and cooperative and has shown much understanding to
17 the problems peculiar to Alaska; and

18 WHEREAS, the Army is phasing out its highly successful oper-
19 ation to the Air Force;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the commander, staff, and all personnel
21 of the Alaska Communication System are highly commended for their
22 unstinted devotion to duty and unexcelled performance of their
23 mission in Alaska; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
25 the Honorable Robert S. McNamara, Secretary of Defense; the
26 Honorable Cyrus R. Vance, Secretary of the Army; Colonel
27 Alexander Alvarado, Commander, Alaska Communication System; to
28 all Alaska Communication System units; and to the members of the
29 Alaska Delegation in Congress.
