5 Proposing an amendment to Article
6 IX, Finance and Taxation, of the
7 Constitution of the State of
8 Alaska.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 That the following amendment to Section 6, Article IX, of
11 the Constitution of the State of Alaska is proposed:

12 "Section 6. No tax shall be levied, or appropriation
13 of public money made, or public property transferred, nor
14 shall the public credit be used, except for a public purpose.
15 Every act of the legislature imposing a new tax or increasing
16 an existing tax shall be referred to the voters of the state
17 for approval or rejection at the first statewide election
18 held more than 90 days after its enactment. The act shall
19 be referred in the same manner as an act referred according
20 to Article XI and it may not take effect until 60 days after
21 its approval."; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary of state shall prepare a
23 ballot title and proposition summarizing this proposed constitu-
24 tional amendment and place them on the ballot as prescribed by the
25 state constitution and the election laws.
