BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has asked the

Congress for a Coast Guard facilities construction program during

10

fiscal 1965 in the amount of \$1,858,000; and

WHEREAS, the proposed construction program includes family

12

housing units and support facilities at Annette Island; maintenance

13

facilities at Ketchikan; and the replacement of the runway at the

14

Coast Guard Loran station on Sitkinak Island; and

15

WHEREAS, these facilities are needed for the effective con-

16

tinuation of the Coast Guard's important mission in Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Congress is requested to give early

18

and favorable consideration to the President's request for the

19

Coast Guard construction program in Alaska during fiscal 1965; and
