BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, the American economy is not growing at the rate  
10 it should; and

11

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Alaska Legislature  
12 that a moderate reduction in federal income taxes to provide  
13 more purchasing power and to free more money for investment will  
14 stimulate economic growth; and

15

WHEREAS, H.R. 8363, first proposed by the late President  
16 Kennedy and supported by President Johnson and most of the  
17 informed labor and business leaders and economists, would provide  
18 such a tax reduction; and

19

WHEREAS, early passage of H.R. 8363 is important not only  
20 to allow the benefits of the reduction to begin to be felt early,  
21 but also to provide certainty for businessmen in planning programs  
22 for expansion;

23

BE IT RESOLVED that the United States Congress is respect-  
24 fully urged to enact H.R. 8363 at the earliest possible moment;
