2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 47

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of a  
6 road giving Metlakatla on Annette  
7 Island access to Ketchikan.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS, the village of Metlakatla and the Coast Guard Station  
10 and airfield on Annette Island are separated from Ketchikan and  
11 other facilities on nearby Revillagigedo Island; and

12 WHEREAS, the construction of a road from Metlakatla to the  
13 nearest point on Annette Island opposite Revillagigedo Island  
14 would facilitate road-ferry communication between Annette Island  
15 and Ketchikan and thereby benefit the inhabitants of Annette  
16 Island by giving them easier access to Ketchikan and the medical  
17 service, hospitalization, shopping facilities, and employment  
18 opportunities it affords; and

19 WHEREAS, the construction of this road with ferry landing  
20 facilities on Annette Island at the nearest point to Revillagigedo  
21 Island would benefit the village of Metlakatla and the government  
22 facilities located on the island reservation;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Delegation in Congress is  
24 requested to communicate with the Department of the Interior and  
25 the Bureau of Indian Affairs requesting them to take action under  
26 Titles 23 and 25, United States Code, for the construction of a  
27 road from Metlakatla to the nearest point on Annette Island  
28 opposite Revillagigedo Island; and be it
